


06 Setting Date & Time




Step 1 — Going to Settings



- Swipe up to view all your apps.
- Scroll down to find Settings, the little gear.

Step 2 — Navigating Settings to Date and Time



- Scroll down and select "System."
- Select "Date and Time."

Step 4 — Setting the Time




- Select "Set Time."
