




06 - Printing Test & Configuration pages



INTRODUCTION


This guide will show you how to print the test and configuration pages you can use to check that your printer is correctly set up.

Step 1 — Open the Printer Driver




- Open the "Printers & Scanners" menu.
- Click on the printer.
- Select the "Manage" option.
- Select "Printer Properties."

Step 2 — Print Test Page from the Driver




- Select the "Tools" tab at the top.
- Click "Print," and from the drop-down menu, select "Generic Test."
- This should print a test label, which should look like the example image.
 - ❗ If no page printed, check that the roll of labels is loaded correctly, and that the correct printing options are selected.

Step 3 — Open the Wireless Utility



- Open the GSS Wireless Setup Utility software used previously.

- Check the box for this printer.
- Hit the "Printer Function" button.
- Choose the option to "Print Test Page."

Step 4 — Print Configuration Page



- Choose the option "Configuration Page."
- The labels should look like the examples listed here.
